WE, the representatives of all parties involved, after much prayer and deliberations, believing that this is God's will for us and our children, have covenanted together in the presence of God Almighty, with one accord-mind, heart, and soul, to establish and maintain Philadelphia Christian School for our children and other children as well.

Whereas, in this Contract-Covenant, we all agreed that Philadelphia Christian School (PCS) shall be established on the ECC land allotted to Philadelphia Evangelical Church for its ministry and custody, and

Whereas, we all agreed that PCS shall be governed by a school board, respectfully represented by the founding entities but it shall be autonomous in its operation, and

Whereas, we all agreed that we will share our resources, talents and skills, and maintain the integrity of our Christian institution and uphold the agreements. bylaws, and constitution of this institution, and

Therefore, be it resolved that we, the undersigned, will guard and protect our school against any destructive entity and policies be it government or otherwise, and in the case where one party is being dissolved, no changes shall be made by any one party without consulting the other existing parties, and

Be it further resolved, that on the day this document is being signed by all parties involved, it will automatically be binding, and so whatever God has joined together let not man separate, so help us God!
